- help to take care of our homes, schools, communities and even the world.



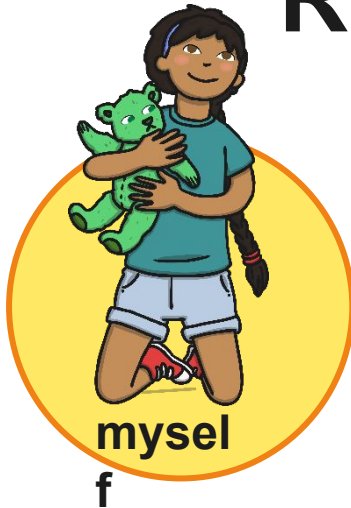
What Happens When We Are Not?
