It was a fascinating day on beautiful grounds and as always the children's values shone through with respectful behaviour and bundles of curiosity!

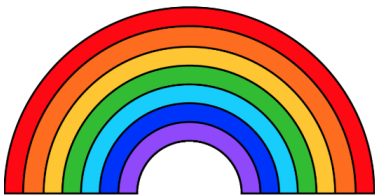

They also had the chance to chat with local residents about how shopping in Flitwick has changed over time. A visiting artist introduced the project further, explaining how the children's drawings and maps will be combined into one large map of the town. Back in school, the pupils worked together to create their own class maps, complete with unique symbols and creative details. These maps are now being developed into "proper" maps and will feature in a special exhibition later this year.
