Unauthorised Leave of Absence in Term Time (Holidays) and Fixed Penalty Notices

Section 7 of the Education Act 1996 places a legal duty on a parent that where their child is registered at a school, they must attend regularly.

DfE statutory guidance contained the 'Working Together to Improve School Attendance' document states that Headteachers may not grant any leave of absence during term time unless there are 'exceptional circumstances'. Where it is evident that a pupil has been taken on 'Leave of Absence' (holiday in term time) without this being authorised by the Headteacher, schools are permitted make a referral for a Fixed Penalty Notice (FPN) request via their local authority, should the absence period meet the CBC Code of Conduct for the issuing of Fixed Penalty Notices, which is based on the national threshold of 10 sessions of unauthorised absence (continuous or culminative) in a 10 week School period.

The DfE does allow a Local Authority the discretion to issue an FPN before the above threshold is met, where it believes that this maybe appropriate. An example of this might be where a parent takes 8 sessions of unauthorised 'Leave of Absence' when a school is only open for 4 days in a week, for instance where there is a Bank Holiday closure or a Teacher Training Day. There may also be other individual circumstances where issuing an FPN outside of the Code of Conduct might be appropriate

Do come along for a tour of the school. You will be shown around in small groups and staff will be available to answer any questions.

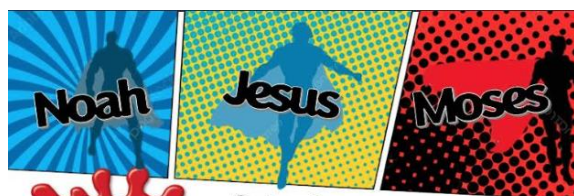
