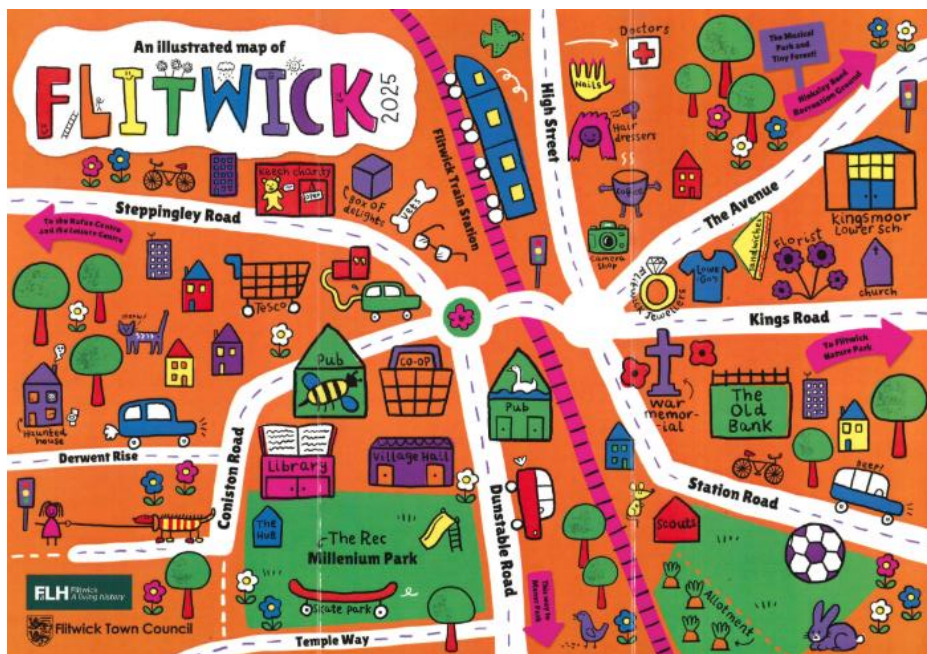

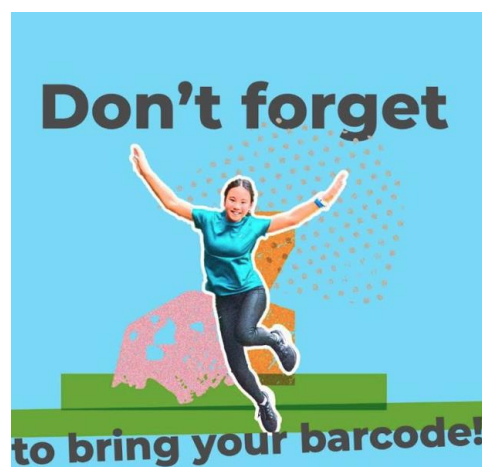
Kingsmoor is now a Parkrun Primary School!

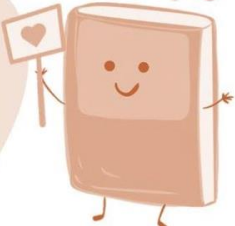
