Use of school car park



Dear Parents and Carers,

I am writing to remind all families of the importance of car park safety and to clarify our expectations regarding its use.

The car park is a shared space and becomes particularly busy and potentially hazardous during peak times—especially around **8:50 am and 3:15 pm**, when many of our children and families are arriving and leaving school. I ask that you take extra care during these periods to ensure the safety of everyone on site. We are particularly mindful of our **Year 4 students**, many of whom are now walking to and from school independently. Their safety is a key priority, and it is vital that they are able to move through the car park and surrounding areas safely and confidently.

To support the safety of all children and families:

The carpark should **only be used if prior agreement has been made with the school.**

If you must use the car park, we ask you to **please arrive earlier** and **leave the car park later** to avoid the busiest times.

Always be vigilant and drive slowly and cautiously within the car park.

Please follow any guidance or directions from staff on duty.

Please contact the school office for a **car park badge** which will be allocated if you have permission to use the car park only. This can be displayed on the dashboard of your car to avoid any confusion.

Thank you for your ongoing cooperation and for helping us to maintain a safe environment for all members of our school community.

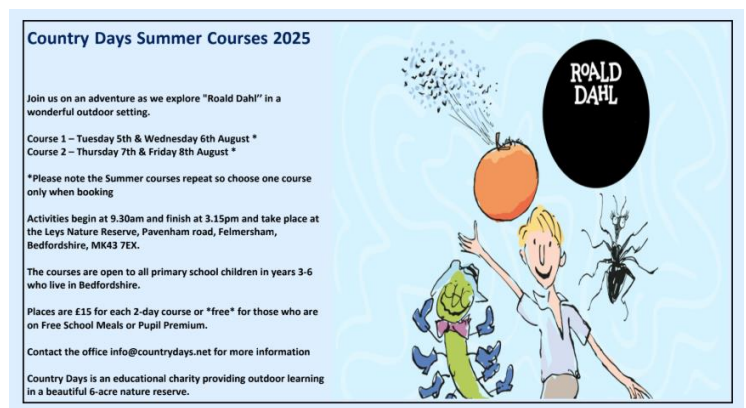
