Internet Safety Parent Session

Thursday 13th February at 5pm

Kingsmoor Lower School with Paul

Paul is a highly experienced detective with over 15 years of service in law enforcement. He has advised government bodies and Ofcom on the role social media plays in violent crime, the supply of illegal weapons and drugs, and the exploitation of children. Having seen firsthand how social media and the internet can impact children's well-being and safety, Paul brings valuable insights into the risks families face online and how to tackle them.

This session, not suitable for under-16s, is thoughtfully tailored for parents and will cover crucial topics, including understanding popular social media platforms, the risks of not being familiar with those platforms, and how people target children for criminal, sexual, and financial exploitation. Paul will also discuss the devastating consequences that can arise when things go tragically wrong. Drawing on real-world investigations he has worked on, Paul will offer practical advice to help parents navigate the digital world with greater confidence and awareness.
