Dear Parents and Carers,

It has certainly been a 'hit the ground running' start to the term! As you know we welcomed Ofsted into school this week. Although we knew that we were due an inspection, it is always a bit of a shock when we get the call. We were called just before 10 am on Monday and they were in school at 7.50 am the following day. This gives no time to do anything different in terms of planning, teaching and general school routines. I told the lead inspector during our telephone meeting on Monday that Kingsmoor is in a good place and that is what they would see and that is what was confirmed on this two day graded inspection.

Whilst an overall judgement is not made anymore; the areas that are inspected are. These have been shared with our senior leaders including governors but cannot be shared further until the inspection report has been quality assured and agreed by us. This has a 60 day turnaround but I have been assured that it is usually much quicker than this. I will of course share this with you as soon as it is.

I would like to thank you all for the overwhelming show of support through the parent questionnaires, emailed messages of good luck and encouragement and face to face conversations. The inspectors commented during their feedback about this being unusual but noted that it demonstrated how happy families are with the Kingsmoor offer, from our results, provision for all groups and strong relationships your voice was heard!

A snapshot of what was seen during the inspection will be recorded in the report but I do want to share that the most striking aspect of Kingsmoor for the inspectors was our pupils. As a school should be, the pupils are at the centre of everything. Ofsted observed that children are polite, respectful, eager to learn, confident to speak about their views and experiences at Kingsmoor and thrive in a safe and happy environment. Attendance has also impressed and demonstrated that children want to be in school.

As a celebration for this positive experience children have been treated to a cinema experience today with a choice of film and popcorn, kindly provided by our PTA along with a non uniform day.

Are you Interested In Becoming A Foster Carer?

The key things we require of you:

- have a spare room which will be used solely by the foster child.
- be willing to commit to learning and developing the skills needed to be a reflective, empathetic foster carer who understands the impact of early life trauma. Training is an essential part of the fostering role.
- be willing to engage in the fostering assessment process.
- be willing to bounce back when a child needs you the most.
- be willing to undergo a health assessment to confirm you are fit and well enough to carry out the role.
- be willing to complete an enhanced DBS disclosure to confirm you are safe to work with children.
- understand the importance of supporting a child's journey, education, growth and family connections.
- understand and appreciate that it can be a very challenging role.....but also an extremely rewarding one!

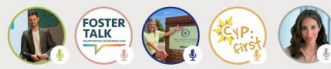
