Key Stage 1

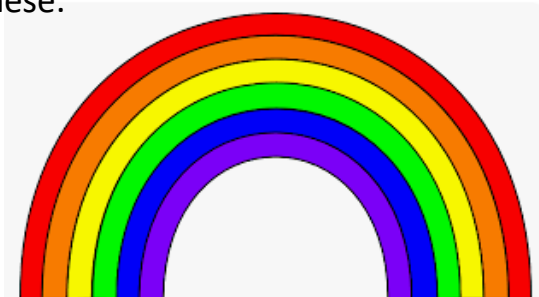
Have been working hard in writing this week. They have been writing instructions for something of their own choice, which have proved to be very enjoyable to read (some examples have been included later on).
