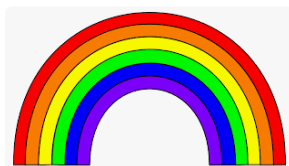

Measles cases on the rise: vaccination reminder

Parents and carers are being urged to check their children's vaccination status, following an increase in measles cases in the UK. The disease is so infectious that the NHS is warning that as many as nine out of ten unvaccinated children would be susceptible to measles if a single classmate brought it into school. If families have missed an appointment or would like to have their child vaccinated, the vaccination is available. The NHS offers not only routine immunisation programmes for children under the age of five but also schedules up to the teenage years for those who have missed a vaccination. Financial support available for victim survivors of Domestic Abuse

Those without the financial means to leave their abusers will be able to apply for a one-off payment of up to £500 via one of over 470 support services, for essential items such as groceries, nappies or support with new accommodation to help them and their children flee to safety.

For the first time, victim survivors can also apply for a further one-off payment of up to £2,500 to help secure a sustainable independent future, such as putting down a deposit for rental accommodation.
