Year 1's Exciting Trip to the Train Station

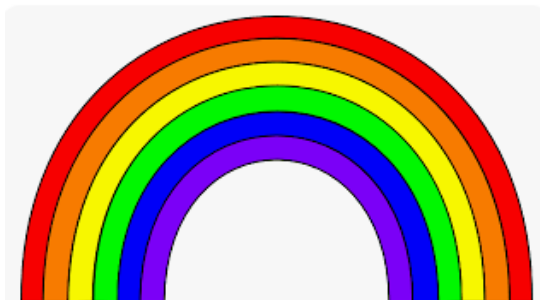

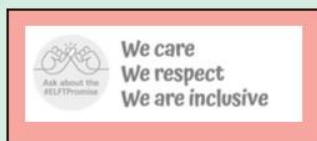
